

PUBLIC NOTICE  
TO THE RESIDENTS OF THE SETTLEMENT OF COLVILLE LAKE  
(Behdzi Ahda" First Nation)

The Minister of Municipal and Community Affairs, Government of the Northwest Territories has received a letter from the Behdzi Ahda" First Nation asking that a Charter Community be established.

The Behdzi Ahda" First Nation Government, a municipal corporation under the *Charter Communities Act*, is proposed for establishment on April 1, 2010. The proposed date for the election of a new Council to take office on the proposed establishment date is March 1, 2010.


The boundaries of the Behdzi Ahda" First Nation Government are proposed to be the same as the boundaries of the Settlement of Colville Lake. They are described as:

The Behdzi Ahda" First Nation Government consists of that portion of the Northwest Territories in the vicinity of the community of Colville Lake as shown on Edition 1 of the 1:50,000 scale National Topographic Series Map 96 M/1, produced by the Department of Natural Resources, Canada, bounded as follows:

Commencing at the point of intersection of latitude 67° 03' N and longitude 126° 00' W;  
thence south in a straight line to the intersection of latitude 67° 00' N and longitude 126° 00' W;  
thence west in a straight line to the intersection of latitude 67° 00' N and longitude 126° 10' W;  
thence north in a straight line to the intersection of latitude 67° 03' N and longitude 126° 10' W;  
All geographic coordinates contained in this description are referred to the North American Datum NAD27.

Residents who object to the proposed municipality may, by writing to the Minister, object to the establishment of the proposed Charter Community. In order to be considered, an objection must be received by the Minister within 90 days after the signing of this public notice.
