

Eligibility of Voters Notice TliCho Elections

The Tłıchǫ Community Governments follow the *Local Authorities Elections Act* except as noted in the *Tłıchǫ Community Government Act* in regards to eligibility of voters and candidates, council vacancies and tie votes.

A person is eligible to vote for Councillors if they:

- Are a Canadian citizen or permanent resident on Election Day;
- Have attained 18 years on election day;
- Have been a resident of the community for at least six months immediately preceding election day; and
- Have been a resident of Mǫwhì Gogha Dè Nı̀tlèè for at least two years immediately preceding Election Day (includes Yellowknife, Dettah, and N'dilo).

A person is eligible to vote for Chief if:

- In addition to the above criteria, the voter must be a Tłıchǫ citizen.

NOTE: It is an offence under the *Local Authorities Election Act* (s. 68, 106, 110) to vote if a person is not eligible to do so.
