



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS: How will I get home?

Community Re-Entry for K'asho Got'ine/Fort Good Hope Evacuees

HOW WILL I KNOW WHEN I CAN GO HOME?

The Fort Good Hope Community Government will make an announcement when it is safe for evacuees to return. This will be shared at the evacuation centres and on social media.

HOW DO I SIGN UP FOR A FLIGHT HOME?

If you are a registered evacuee, arrangements will automatically be made to arrange you a flight home. Someone from the GNWT will call you with your flight information. Flight manifests will also be posted at the school gym once flights are scheduled.

WHERE SHOULD I GO BEFORE GETTING ON A FLIGHT?

If you are in Norman Wells, rides to the airport will be facilitated at the school gym.

HOW MANY BAGS CAN I BRING WITH ME?

Passengers on repatriation flights are asked to follow a two-bag limit. For more information, please ask evacuation centre staff or contact regional staff listed on this document.

WILL MY BAGS BE SEARCHED?

Yes. There is a prohibition order currently in place for Fort Good Hope. The community government has advised that they plan to search luggage upon arrival in Fort Good Hope.

WHAT IF I DON'T GET ON A REPATRIATION FLIGHT?

Every effort will be made to provide each registered evacuee a flight home. If you willfully choose to miss your flight, you will then be responsible for getting yourself home.

WHAT WILL BE DONE TO MAKE SURE ALL EVACUEES ARE FOUND AND OFFERED A FLIGHT HOME?

Community representatives will be working to make sure all registered evacuees have the opportunity to return home. Names and contact information have already been gathered for all registered evacuees.

WHAT IF I HAVEN'T REGISTERED AS AN EVACUEE YET?

Any Fort Good Hope resident can still register at the evacuation centre in Norman Wells and will be given a flight home. Registration will close when the evacuation centre is stood down.
