	(b) a judgement in respect of a claim arising out of a sale to which Part VII of the <i>Consumer Protection Act</i> applies, is given against the Principal or against any representative, agent or salesman of the Principal;						
	(c) the Principal commits an act of bankruptcy, whether or not proceedings have been taken under the <i>Bankruptcy Act</i> (Canada); or						
	 (d) a decision is rendered by the Director in writing stating in effect that after consideration and investigation of a complaint, he is satisfied that the Principal, of any representative, agent of salesman of the Principal, (i) has violated any provision of the Consumer Protection Act or has failed to comply with any of the terms, conditions or restrictions to which his licence is subject or is in breach of contract, and
